Dear Director Young and Under Secretary Spinrad,

As you work to complete the Administration's budget request for Fiscal Year 2024 (FY24), I encourage you to include the full authorization of \$4 million for NOAA's Digital Coast activities. The Digital Coast program, authorized in (P.L. 116-223), provides coastal communities with the data, tools, and training needed to manage coastal resources, enhance community resilience and strengthen economic development.

More specifically, Digital Coast provides leaders of vulnerable coastal and Great Lakes communities with the essential resources needed to predict, plan for, and mitigate the impacts of storms, flooding and natural disasters by consolidating data from a wide variety of sources into a single publicly accessible, easy-to-use interface. The breadth and interoperability of the data within the Digital Coast platform, combined with trainings for coastal management practitioners, empowers local leaders in both the public and private sector to dramatically improve the efficacy of coastal management projects.

Digital Coast has become an essential tool that coastal managers across the country rely on. A NOAA survey found that 75 percent of Digital Coast users indicated that their projects would not have been possible without Digital Coast. Further, NOAA predicts over a 400 percent return on investment from Digital Coast.

As Digital Coast is utilized in communities across the country, the program should not be underestimated in the federal budget planning process. Full support of Digital Coast in the FY24 Budget Request will ensure communities have continued access to the up-to-date data, tools and training resources necessary for supporting the economic development and disaster prevention in coastal communities.
